## May Meeting

As Americans, we all have a duty and responsibility to know from whence we came that we may use this knowledge in addressing the issues of today. Fortunately, there is no shortage of opportunities to learn the history that we all share. One such opportunity was the fascinating presentation by Phil Caine, a former brigadier general and now author/historian. Caine presented and illustrated a part of history that he holds dear as it was a defining moment in our nations past. Mr. Caine specializes in the RAF Eagle squadrons, a group of American civilians who crossed the Atlantic to fly for the Royal Air Force before the U.S. entered the conflict in 1941.

While Caine did draw reference to the Eagle squadrons several times in the course of his lecture, the main emphasis of the night's proceedings was on the aviation side of WWII in a more general sense. Caine expounded upon the life and labor of B-17 and B-24 air crews as well as the plight of the single engine fighter pilots. The highlights of the presentation were Caine's recounting of stories of pilots forced to bail out of their craft, and those of the constant peril faced by the aviators of the time.

For me, knowledge like that which I received today is invaluable and will indubitably be helpful in the future. I enjoy history; I think it is a gateway to other experiences that in many ways have bearings on my life. We can all learn allot from the WWII aviators, not only about the art and science of aviation, but in their willingness to brave the odds in the name of freedom. We owe it to ourselves to read books like *Spitfires*, *Thunderbolts*, and *Warm Beer*, or *Aircraft Down* because their experience is what makes our lives as we know it possible.
