Next Meeting : Breakfast and "Buddy Rides"

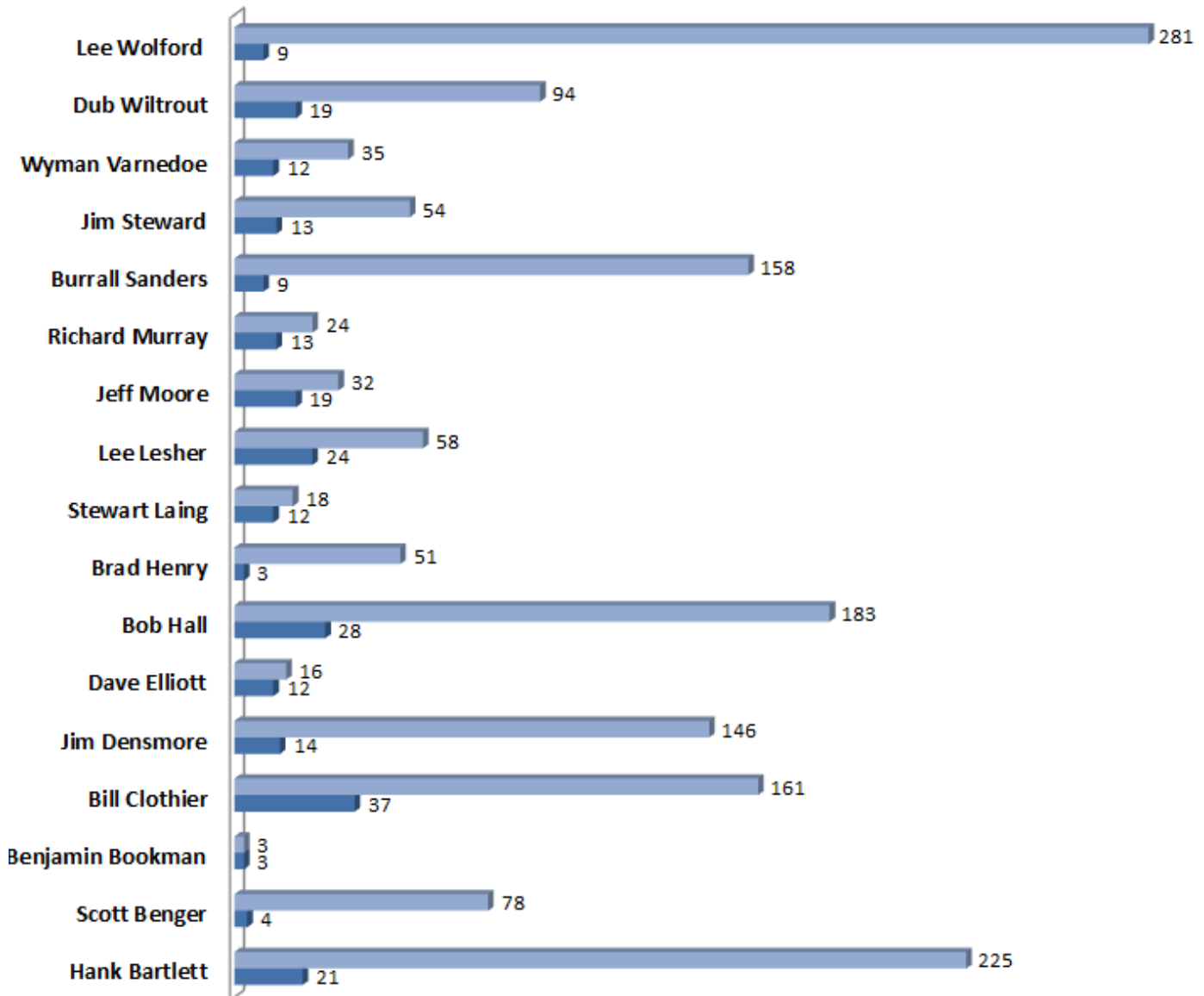

Notice to Young Eagle Pilots

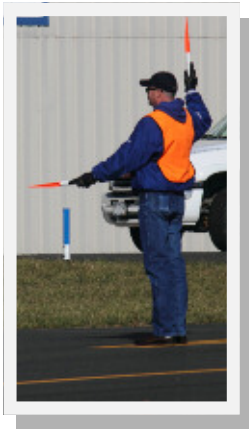

October proved to be a great turnout for our last Young Eagle rally in 2013.



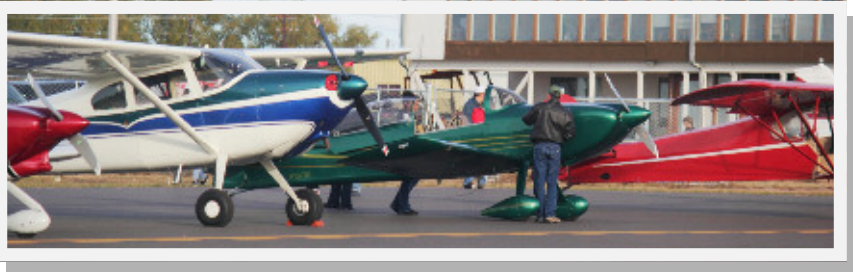
Brian Esch and Chris Sedgwick provided safe aircraft movement.
